Anti-Viral Deep Cleaning Service from South East Cleaning

South East Cleaning offers a thorough UK-wide anti-viral sanitisation service. It is particularly popular and relevant to everyone in this Coronavirus era.

We firstly sanitise the area in question using fogging/mist application by machine using either hand-held or mounted backpack. (we use RTU VIRO-KILL chemical) This ensures that even non-wipeable surfaces are sanitised. (See Three Stage Cleaning Below) We take extra care around your IT and electrical equipment.

Three stage cleaning

Stage 1. Fogging/mist spray all areas including bins, desks, furnishings, furniture & floors using VIRO-KILL disinfectant chemicals, without any physical contact by any of our operatives, and allow the VIRO-Kill to do its work (approximately 20-30 minutes)

Stage 2. Deep clean all areas, as per our normal deep cleaning regime, empty bins and remove all rubbish and dispose of, under government guidelines.

Stage 3. Revisit area and reapply as per Stage 1. Rotating/moving furnishings and any movable items before commencing the fogging/mist disinfecting, giving a total coverage of disinfectant to all items.

Fogging/Misting and Decontamination FAQ's

Will surfaces be wet, and will it damage IT equipment?

No, the spray is emitted in tiny microns that will not form a wet surface on IT or paperwork.

How soon can I return to the area to work?

We recommend you can return after approximately 30 minutes from completion.

Will the effect wear off once the surface is later re-cleaned?

No, routine cleaning can take place and will not disrupt the VIRO-KILL molecule or its molecular activity.

What prep work is required?

Our technicians will prepare the area, remove food, and will rotate items that are lying on desks and tables.

Is VIRO-KILL toxic?

No, VIRO-KILL is water-based, non-toxic and non-alcohol based, and provides unique proven and long-lasting protection. It is odourless and colourless.

How does a fogging machine work?

The fogger uses pressure to create a fine mist (or fog) which is applied to the targeted area, the spray density typically being moderated by a manual valve to ensure the optimum effect. The fine fog can reach into corners and difficult areas and may also penetrate porous surfaces.
