#### **Policy Statement**

St George's makes sure it is maintaining and operating the minibus safely and ensures the safety of the children when travelling in the minibus.

#### **Procedures**

These procedures will keep the minibus in good working order and ensure the safety of the children and staff at St George's:

- A full service and a Ministry of Transport Test will be carried out on the minibus annually.
- Advice will be taken from mechanical specialists as to any repairs required to maintain the vehicle in a safe working order.
- The checking of oil, water, battery, tyre pressures and diesel will be carried out at least each month by the caretaker/driver. All checks and actions taken are recorded in the maintenance log.
- Drivers of the minibus must:
  - hold a D1 PCV Licence,
  - be over 21 and have held a licence for more than 2 years,
  - have passed the KCC Minibus Driver's Course,
  - be free of any restrictions enforced by the Insurance Company.
  - adhere to the laws of the road.
- The minibus is never reversed without someone supervising and ensuring that no-one is at risk.
- A fire extinguisher and a first aid box will always be carried on the minibus.
- The minibus must always be locked and immobilised when parked.

- All passengers must have their seat belts secured and adjusted according to their size before moving off.
- Windows must only be opened on the supervision of an adult.
- No children to travel in the front seats, back seats adjacent to the rear doors or beside sliding door unless the vehicle is fully occupied.
- Passengers must not cause any nuisance that will distract the driver or any other motorist whilst in transit.
- Children will not be allowed to board or alight from the minibus without an adult's supervision.
- Number of children will be checked when boarding the minibus and taken again on their return trip.
- No food (this includes sweets) or drink is to be consumed whilst the minibus is in motion. All aisles of the minibus must be kept free from bags etc.
- Staff must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs when driving the minibus. Any person taking prescribed drugs will require the agreement of the Insurance Company prior to driving the minibus.
- When in motion, all minibus doors to be securely closed but not locked.

#### **School Bus Collection Ratios**

- Children between 4 and 11 years – 1 Adult to 6 Children
- The Driver will always be accompanied on the minibus by an additional member of staff and will never be in sole charge of a child.
